

MALAHAT (s)

- This variety ripens much as one week earlier than Meeker
- Size of fruit is medium to large, medium red color
- Firm fruit, conic in shape, easy to pick
- The fruit is not as sweet as Tulameen, but the flavor is very acceptable
- Plants are moderately vigorous and relatively upright

WILLAMETTE

- An early season variety, some days after Malahat (s)
- Average size, round shape, dark and bright red colour
- Little spiny and vigorous canes, resistant to winter frost
- Mainly used for industrial freezing and processing
- Willamette is also suitable for mechanical harvesting

MEEKER

- Very robust variety
- vigorous growth
- Firm juicy dark red fruit with a high sugar content, excellent taste
- Average size
- Mid-season variety

TULAMEEN

- A mid-season variety picking over a long period
- The attractive glossy berries are large and firm
- Excellent flavor
- Strong vigorous canes with few spines
- Susceptible to Root Rot and other diseases

GLEN AMPLE (s)

- A mid-season, vigorous, spine-free variety
- Glen Ample (s) produce consistently high yields in commercial production
- Large, fleshy berries, round in shape
- The berries are firm with a pleasant aromatic flavor
- The fruit has excellent shelf-life

SAN RAFAEL (s)

- New variety in early to mid-season
- Excellent fruit quality
- Excellent taste with delicate balance between sweetness and acidity
- The attractive glossy berries are large and firm
- Robust plant, vigorous growth

AUTUMN BLISS

- Cropping from the end of July until the first frosts
- This variety produces medium sized berries with a pleasant flavour
- The short erect, strong canes need only a minimum of support
- Very robust plant and roots

ENROSADIRA (s)

- Early season
- Attractive, very large, bright red conically shaped berries of high quality
- Easily picked, firm fruit with excellent aromatic flavor and very good self-life
- vigorous selection
- Highly productive when cropped as a primocane and florican
- Enrosadira (s) is the most promising primocane to be launched in the last few years

HIMBO TOP® rafzeter (s)

- Late season variety with peak production in September
- Large, bright berries, that detach easily
- Moderate taste
- The berries do not darken after picking
- Moderate firmness of berries
- Long, vigorous canes
- Also suited for crop as florican

POLKA (s)

- Polish bred variety
- Large, evenly conical berries with excellent flavor
- Firm berries with good shelf-life, but darken after picking
- Growth middle to vigorous
- Polka (s) needs more fertilization as other varieties
